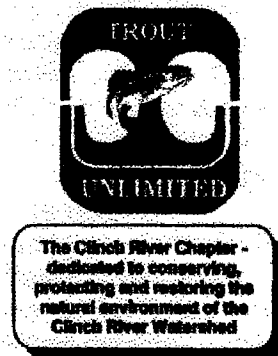


THE CLINCH RIVER ANGLER
